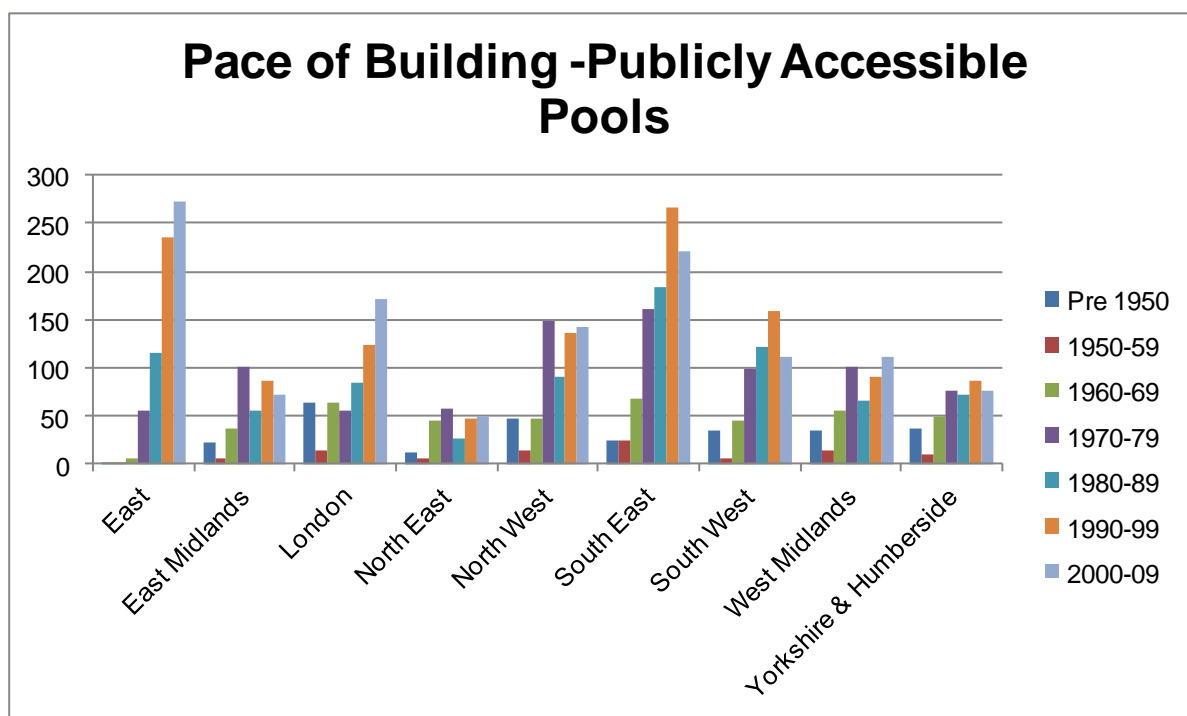


The national picture of swimming pools

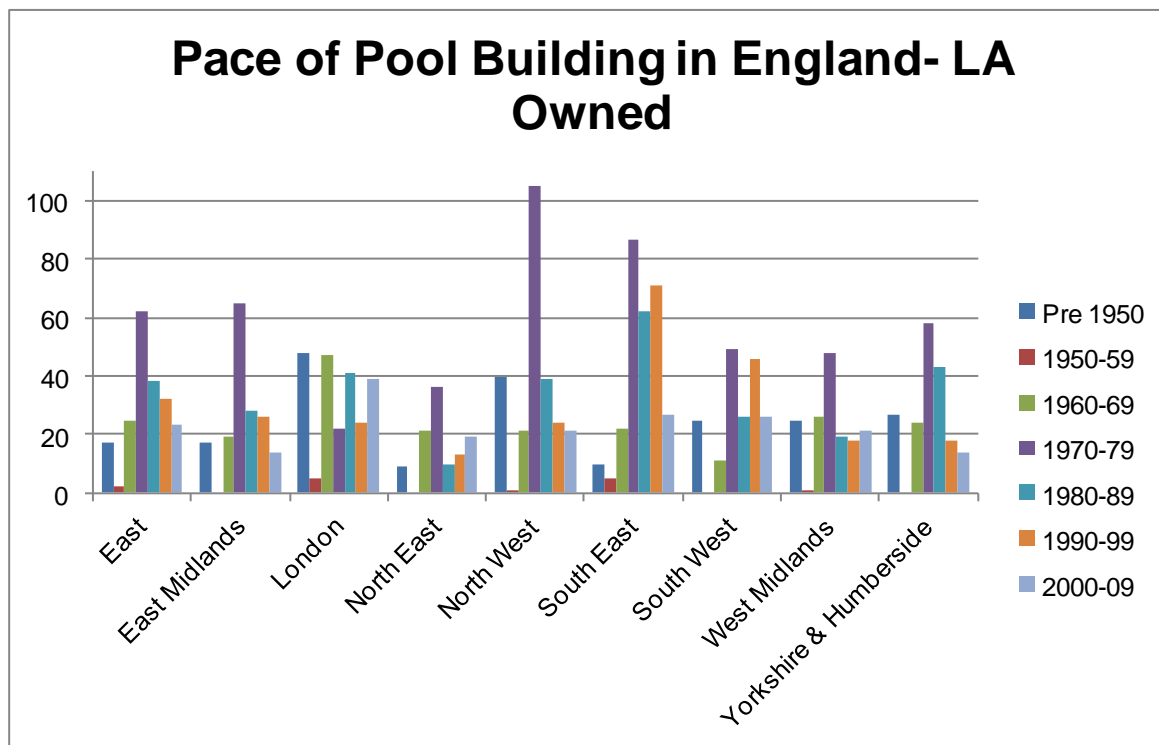
